



MFR CONTESTANT INFO

Hello MFR Contestants – please find a quick schedule summary and some info for you as you get ready to head to the Manitoba Finals Rodeo!!

- Wednesday October 25 – Horses are allowed to be on site – stalling is all labeled and the MRCA Rodeo stalls are located in the Manitoba Room – If you did not previously book to stall on Wednesday just send the office a quick email and it will be added to your receipts.
- UNLOADING – Please unload by the Manitoba Room Doors or Barn 11 – Signs will be posted and I have attached a map of the facility.
- Thursday October 26 –
 - Open Riding 7-9AM and 2:30-3:30PM – this will be the ONLY time you can get into the Main Arena. We share this open riding with all groups – so no barrels will be allowed.
 - Rodeo Office Opens at 1PM – 4PM for Entries, you will also receive your coats.
 - Thursday Grand Entry is MILITARY & CANADA 150 NIGHT – We encourage you to wear RED or WHITE or a combo of both!! ALL CONTESTANTS ARE REQUIRED TO PARTICIPATE IN GRAND ENTRY!!
 - Contestant Meeting is at 4:45PM by the Ag Ex Barn Bar (the Westoba Ag Centre Arena)
 - Contestant Pictures at 5:30PM – Main Arena
 - 1st Perf of MFR at 7PM
 - Year End Awards will be 30 minutes following the rodeo perf at the MNP Room (by VIP Lounge in Main concourse) Beverages and snacks will be available for purchase, all Year End Winners MUST attend.
- Friday October 28 –
 - 4:15PM (Subject to change so please check at the office) Horse of the Year Winner Interviews in the upper hitching ring
 - Friday Grand Entry is RETRO NIGHT – Dig out those retro shirts, pants and hats!! 2nd Perf of MFR at 7PM – Thursday night Round Winners are asked to participate in Grand Entry
- Saturday October 29 –
 - Saturday Grand Entry is Championship Saturday – All leaders heading in to the final round will be asked to participate in Grand Entry
 - Final MFR Perf at 7PM – All Finals Champions will be awarded in the Main Arena

More details about Grand Entry will be provided at the contestant meeting on Thursday. We thank all of you for participating when asked.

- Camping/Parking – If you booked an electrical site through Provincial Ex you will receive your info from them. If you have not booked an electrical site all parking/camping will be on the South East corner of the Keystone grounds – there will be NO trailer parking close to the barns except for day competitors – this will be closely monitored.
